Evolution of Full Arch Rehab w/Immediate Load

David Jurman, DDS, MD, FACS and Andrew J. Pacinelli, DMD

Course Description:

This course will discuss the journey of full arch immediate load workflow from analog to digital and combining both treatment planning modalities to predictable treatment outcomes. Dr. Pacinelli and I will discuss surgical and restorative considerations as well as how to discuss treatment options with patients.

Course Objectives:

We will review various types of cases and how to determine which patients are ideal for full arch treatment and which are not. Other topics we will discuss are the different parts and pieces needed to execute the implant surgery as well as the conversion of the temporary prosthesis. We will also go over various types of definitive restorations that you can choose from. Lastly, we will discuss with you the preoperative and postoperative instructions along with the financial breakdown of the procedure. Several cases will be presented at the end of the lecture to review take-home points

BIOs: Dr. Jurman grew up in Dix Hills and attended the Half Hollow Hills School District. After graduation, he attended Pennsylvania State University where he earned his bachelor's degree in Biology.
